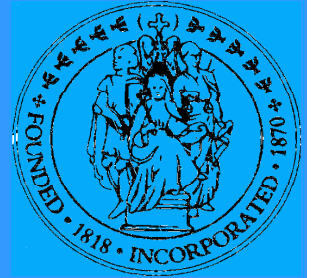


A Birmingham Law Society Conference: The Future Of Legal Services
